Downtown Revitalization

The town was awarded \$300,000 for downtown improvements and the planning piece is almost complete. The money will be used to re-design the Western side of the intersection at the stoplight. There are currently three options being considered that will see water line upgrades, landscaping, new curb & gutter installment, parking layout, and new pavement to make the area more attractive and easier to access.

This is just the beginning of downtown improvements that are being planned. Commissioners will vote on the design of choice by the first of the year. Construction will commence as soon as the bidding process is complete.

PeachTree Works Chooses Candor!

Candor recently received some great news on the economic development front!! PeachTree Works, a subsidiary of Braxton Culler of Sophia NC, has purchased the old Klaussner plant in Candor. This deal has been in the works for two years as the company has been watching the shift towards U.S. made manufacturing strengthen.


They have moved in and are currently upfitting the plant to begin production. They will invest \$5 million dollars and create 25 new jobs in the area. Another project that is occurring behind-the-scenes, is the marketing and branding of the Town of Candor. This coincides with planning the town's future as development begins to move our way via the I-73/74 Corridor, and also as Moore County's growth expands with the widening of Hwy 211.

Our park will be a tremendous asset to the town, as well as the water system improvements AND downtown streetscape refinement that will be in place in the very near future. 

Skillet Peach Cake

1/4 c butter 1 c pecans (chopped) 3/4 c brown sugar 1/4 ts salt

2 eggs (beaten) 1 c sugar

 $\begin{array}{ll} \hbox{1 c sliced peaches} & \hbox{1 ts baking powder} \\ \hbox{1 ts vanilla} & \hbox{how many tb is $\frac{1}{4}$ c} \end{array}$

1/2 c milk 1 c flour

Melt ¼ c butter in a 9" skillet. Add brown sugar and chopped pecans. Arrange sliced peaches. Then: Add eggs and gradually add salt and sugar. Add: milk, 1tb butter, vanilla and mix ingredients together. Blend in flour and baking powder. Pour batter over fruit and bake at 350 degrees F for 30-40 minutes. Serve upside down with whipped cream.

A Bit of History...

"Candor in its own right is different from all other Montgomery County towns. It possesses both the stately pines of the Piedmont, prides itself in its vast, sprawling peach orchards and claims the sand of the seacoast.

...in the beginning, around 1873, it was called "Lamonds Old Field"...

...three prominent merchants (Elsie Shamburger, A.B. McCaskill and Samuel Parsons) are credited with giving the settlement its present name when they chose "Candor", envisioning a town of frankness and sincerity."

Peach trees should never be planted in clay soil. Their roots do not like the location of deep wet and dense soil which are all characteristic of clay. The sandy, loose consistency of the soil found in the Sandhills are ideal for peach trees.
